## Anointed and called by God

## Let your light shine

Be encouraged by the example of Daniel and Joseph from the Old Testament. They are wonderful examples of men who did not compromise their faith and yet were given favour and respect by the authorities. As a result of this favoured position the Lord was able to pour His blessing upon all of their circumstances.

## We need to rise above compromise and have a healthy FEAR of the LORD.

When pressure comes to force us to conform to the world, we need to resist it knowing that God will honour us as we obey Him. Proverbs 29:26 says

"Many seek the ruler's favour but justice comes from the Lord."

## Spirit food
