Prayer Works

Let the word of God be the standard for your prayers

Hold onto these promises regarding prayer:

"Again I tell you, if two of you on earth agree (harmonize together, together make a symphony) about - anything and everything - whatever they shall ask, it will come to pass and be done for them by my Father in Heaven. For wherever two or three are gathered (drawn together as My followers) in (into) My Name, there I am in the midst of them."

Matthew 18:19-20

"And whatever you ask for in prayer, having faith and (really) believing, you will receive."

Matthew 21:22

"If you live in Me - abide vitally united to Me - and My words remain in you and continue to live in your hearts, ask whatever you will and it shall be done for you."

John 15:7

"Keep on asking and it will be given you; keep on seeking and you will find; keep on knocking (reverently) and the door will be opened to you. For everyone who keeps on asking receives, and he who keeps on seeking finds, and to him who keeps on knocking it will be opened."

Matthew 7:7-8

"Now to Him Who, by (in consequence of) the (action of His) power that is at work within us, is able to (carry out His purpose and) do superabundantly, far over and above all that we (dare) ask or think - infinitely beyond our highest prayers, desires thoughts, hopes or dreams. To Him be glory in the Church and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations forever and ever. Amen-so be it."

Ephesians 3:20-21.

Pray the answer not the problem

Step 1: Identify the problem

Step 2: Find a scripture passage or a Bible story that relates to your situation.

For example:

Problem: Child stressed over exams.

Answer: *"For God has not given us a spirit of fear but of power and of love and of a sound mind."*

2 Timothy 1:7 (NKJ)

Step 3: Pray the scripture passage rather than focusing on the problem.

Step 4: Once you have prayed, refuse to dwell on the problem, take the negative thoughts captive to Christ by focusing on the word of God.

Suggested scripture verses specifically for children:

Pray for their confidence:

"I can do everything through Him who gives me strength."

Philippians 4:13 (NIV)

Pray for their future:

"For I know the thoughts and plans that I have for you says the Lord, thoughts and plans for welfare and peace and not for evil, to give you hope in your final outcome."

Jeremiah 29:11

Pray for their Salvation:

"So they said Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ and you will be saved you and your household."

Acts 16:31

Pray for their Christian commitment:

"Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind and with all your strength"

Mark 12:30

Release from Drugs, Alcohol and Eating Disorders:

"For the weapons of our warfare are not physical weapons of flesh and blood but they are mighty before God for the overthrow and destruction of strongholds."

2 Corinthians 10:4

Release from the occult:

"The Father has delivered and drawn us to Himself out of the control and the dominion of darkness and has transferred us into the kingdom of the Son of His love."

Colossians 1:13

Release from peer pressure:

"You are of God little children and have overcome them, because He who is in you is greater than he who is in the world."

1 John 4:4

Scripture verses specifically for school needs:

Pray for Federal and State Minister for Education and all teaching staff:

"Therefore, I exhort first of all that supplications, prayers and intercessions and giving of thanks, be made for all men, for kings, and all who are in authority, that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and reverence."

1 Timothy 2:1-4

Pray for teachers and school principals to seek wisdom from God:

"...that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory may give to you the spirit of wisdom."

Ephesians 1:17-20.

Pray for Christian students and teachers to be bold:

"For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ for it is the power of God to salvation for everyone who believes. For the Jew first and also for the Greek."

Romans 1:16

Fear-proof your school. Pray for God's love to be known:

"There is no fear in love (dread does not exist) but full grown (complete, perfect) love turns fear out of doors and expels every trace of terror."

1 John 4:18

Pray for the curriculum:

"We are destroying speculations and every lofty thing raised up against the knowledge of God, and we are taking every thought captive to the obedience of Christ."

2 Corinthians 10:5

Pray for Youth Workers and scripture teachers:

"Therefore beseech the Lord of the harvest to send out workers into His harvest."

Matthew 9:38

Pray for Christian morals and Spiritual fruits:

"But if you are led by the Spirit you are not under the law...Now the works of the flesh are ...idolatry, sorcery, hatred, outbursts of wrath...those who practice such things will not inherit the kingdom of God. But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control."

Galatians 5:18-23
